The Fast Break

At a Glance: Tonight, the Bighorns look to build on a perfect 5-0 start in their first road contest of the season...this is the best start in franchise history for Reno...Reno is now the last remaining unbeaten team in the NBA Development League...tomorrow, Reno heads to Sioux Falls to complete the infamous Bismarck-Sioux Falls back-to-back.

All-Time Series: Tonight's epic battle marks the 4th all-time meeting between the Bighorns and Brooks Bollinger's Dakota Wizards...Dakota holds the all-time series lead, 2-1...the two teams split a pair of games in 08-09, while Dakota won the only meeting between the two clubs last season (at the D-League Showcase in Boise)...**F Mo Charlo** had 14 points and 14 rebounds in that tilt.

Welcome, Young Whiteside: Earlier this week, Sacramento Kings **C Hassan Whiteside** was assigned to the Bighorns...is the second NBA assignment in franchise history (also Donte Greene, 08-09)...the 7-footer averaged 5.4 blocks per game at Marshall last season, and was named Conference USA Defensive Player of the Year and C-USA Freshman of the Year...Whiteside was taken with the 33rd overall pick in 2010 NBA Draft...in his first game with Reno, Whiteside scored six points and blocked four shots in 13 minutes of action off the bench.

Dishin' Double-Digit Dimes: Wednesday, **G Aaron Miles** dished out 11 assists...was the fourth game this season he has recorded at least 11 assists...is leading the league in assists (10.8 apg) after five games, despite being ejected in the second quarter of the Bighorns game on 11/21...Miles' 54 total assists also leads the league...nobody else in the league has more than 41 assists (Curtis Stinson, IOW)...the all-time single-game Bighorns record for assists in a game is 14, held by David Noel (4/4/09) and Will Blalock (3/13/10)...so far this season, Miles has accounted for 48.2% of the Bighorns' total assists.

'Horns Getting Hacked: Entering tonight's game, the 'Horns lead the D-League in free throws attempted per game (44.4 FTA per game)...Reno has shot more free throws than their opponents in all five games so far this season...Reno has out-shot its opponents 222-152 from the charity stripe this season...**F Patrick Ewing, Jr.** leads the league in FTA/game (11.2 FTA/game)...on 11/21 vs. UTA, Reno attempted 58 free throws, marking the fifth-highest single-game total in the history of the D-League...there have been 36 players that have fouled out of games in the league this season; eight have come against Reno (22.2%).

Biggest Little Notes in the World: The Bighorns finished 13-12 on the road last season...were one of only five teams to finish 09-10 with a winning record on the road...Bighorns **Head Coach Eric Musselman** is familiar with the Dakotas, having coached the Rapid City Thrillers from 1989-95 (191-89, .682)...**F Gerard Anderson** made his professional debut Wednesday vs. IDA after missing the first four games due to an ankle injury...Reno is averaging 110.0 ppg, good for third-best in the league...the Bighorns are also first in the league in SPG and second in APG...**C Nick Fazekas** grabbed 13 rebounds Wednesday...was his third 13-rebound game in five games this season.

RENO, Nev.—Reno trailed by a bucket through three quarters Wednesday, before Aaron Miles and Marcus Landry combined for 25 fourth-quarter points to lift the Bighorns to a 127-117 victory over the Idaho Stampede in the Reno Events Center.

The win caps a perfect 5-0 season-opening stretch at home for the Bighorns, who remain the lone unbeaten team in the NBA Development League. Reno is off to its best start in franchise history.

Patrick Ewing, Jr. led five Bighorns in double figures with 24 points on the day. Miles collected a double-double with 23 points and 11 assists, while Landry chipped-in 21 points, helped by three three-point field goals. Reno received a boost off the bench from Chris Davis, who scored 17 points and grabbed seven boards in 26 minutes. Hassan Whiteside, who joined the Bighorns this week on an NBA assignment from the Sacramento Kings, made his NBA D-League debut with six points, two rebounds and a game-high four blocked shots.

Salim Stoudamire connected on 8-of-13 tries from the floor on his way to a team-high 23 points for the Stampede. Carlos Wheeler added 20 points and seven boards, while Luke Jackson hit 10-of-11 free-throw attempts en route to 20 points off the Idaho bench.

The lead changed hands 20 times on the day, with both teams holding a double-digit advantage in the contest.
