The Fast Break

At a Glance: Tonight, the Bighorns visit Bakersfield looking to win their third-straight game...Reno currently sits atop of the Western Conference, but just 2.5 games separate the 'Horns from the eighth-place Rio Grande Valley Vipers...tonight is the second game in a stretch during which the 'Horns play five games in nine days...Reno's next three games will be played at the Reno Events Center.

All-Time Series: Tonight's epic battle marks the 12th all-time meeting between the Bighorns and **Merle Haggard's Bakersfield Jam**...Reno leads the all-time series, 7-4...the Bighorns took both ends of a back-to-back earlier this season in Reno...Bakersfield has won the last two games played in Bakersfield, including a 118-112 win over Reno last season in the only game Reno has ever played in the Jam Events Center (3/9/10).

Homework Assignments: The Bighorns roster currently boasts two players on assignment from the NBA...**G Jeremy Lin** (Golden State) has played one game with Reno, scoring 10 points and grabbing five boards on 12/28 vs. TUL...Lin was signed by the Warriors as a free agent in July... is the only player in Ivy League history to record 1,450 points, 450 rebounds, 400 assists and 200 steals...**C Hassan Whiteside** (Sacramento) has appeared in nine games for Reno (two starts), averaging 5.6 ppg and 3.4 rpg...currently 4th in the league with 2.9 blocks per game...Whiteside was drafted in the 2nd round (33rd overall) by the Kings in the 2010 NBA Draft.

Dominant Doug: After a slow start to the 2010-11 season, **F Doug Thomas** has turned it on of late...since 12/17 (three games), Thomas is averaging 9.0 ppg and 5.3 ppg (had been averaging 1.1 ppg and 1.6 ppg over first eight games)...has shot 12-15 (80%) from the field over last three games... had made just three total field goals over first eight games...has also recorded six blocks over three-game span (had five blocks in first eight games).

Double-Double Your Pleasure: On 12/28 vs. Tulsa, **G Aaron Miles** recorded his eighth double-double in 13 games this season...are the most double-doubles in the D-League this season...all eight have been double-digit assist nights for Miles...currently leads the league in both total assists (126) and assists per game (9.7)...Miles is the all-time assist leader in Big 12 history.

Defense Mechanisms: The Bighorns are currently second in the league in both blocked shots per game (6.8) and steals per game (10.1)...Reno boasts two players in the Top 5 in the league in steals (**Miles**, 2nd; **Ewing**, 4th) and one player in the Top 5 in blocks (**Whiteside**, 4th)...opponents are scoring just 100.8 ppg (5th in league) against the 'Horns... Reno has allowed fewer than 100 points in three-straight games and seven of their last 11...Reno is 5-2 when allowing fewer than 100 points and 3-0 when surrendering fewer than 90 points.

Biggest Little Notes in the World: On 12/28 vs. TUL, Reno set a season high with 39 defensive rebounds, but mustered a season-low five offensive boards...Tulsa recorded 93 FGA against Reno (season-high for an opponent), but shot just 37.6% from the field (season-low for an opponent)...Reno has used four different starting lineups this season...**G Aaron Miles** and **F Patrick Ewing, Jr.** are the only players who have started all 13 games.

RENO, Nev.—Coming off a three-game road trip and an eight-day layoff, the Reno Bighorns returned to the floor Tuesday night with a 98-91 victory over the Tulsa 66ers in the Reno Events Center.

Marcus Landry led six Bighorns in double figures with 19 points on the night, including three three-point field goals. Patrick Ewing Jr. finished with 17 points, and Aaron Miles recorded 13 in Reno's second-straight victory.

Jeremy Lin, who was sent to Reno today on an NBA assignment from the Golden State Warriors, recorded 10 points in his NBA D-League debut.

Reno led by four through the first quarter and augmented the lead to 17 at the break, but Tulsa would charge back. The 66ers cut the deficit to single digits late in the final period, but the Bighorns held on and kept their perch atop the Western Conference standings.

Latavious Williams led the 66ers with 17 points on the night, while Ryan Reid chipped-in 14.
