The Fast Break

At a Glance: Tonight, Reno looks to win its third-straight game after sweeping last weekend's back-to-back against Bakersfield...the 'Horns are now 12-3 at home this season, including four-straight wins inside the Reno Events Center...with last weekend's sweep, Reno leapfrogged Bakersfield in the standings, and now sits in 3rd place in the Western Conference.

All-Time Series: Tonight's epic battle marks the 4th all-time meeting between the Bighorns and **Eli Pearlstein's Springfield Armor**...Reno holds the all-time series lead, 3-0...Reno swept a 2-game series in Springfield last season, and won the lone game in the Reno Events Center, 106-77 (3/7/10)...was the largest margin of victory for Reno during the 2009-10 season.

I've Got a Sloan To Pick With You: Reno **G Donald Sloan** had 0 turnovers in 40 minutes of action at point guard on Saturday vs. BAK...now has recorded 1 or fewer turnovers in 8-straight games...has just 5 total turnovers in that stretch (250 minutes played)...averaging 1 turnover every 50 minutes during stretch...assist-to-turnover margin during those 8 games is 40-5 (8.0-1 assist-to-turnover ratio)...as a team, Reno committed just 8 turnovers on Saturday...tied the franchise record for fewest turnovers in a game (1/17/09 vs. UTA)...during Sloan's 8-game streak, the 'Horns have committed 109 TO (13.6 per game), and have forced 146 TO (18.3 per game)...on the season, Reno is 2nd in the league with a +3.1 TOPG margin.

81 Is Getting It Done: The Bighorns allowed just 81 points in Saturday's win...marks the lowest point total Reno has allowed this season and the fourth-lowest in franchise history...gave up 38 points in the second half...the franchise record for points allowed is 77, set on 3/7/10 vs. Springfield...Reno is 10-1 all-time when allowing 85 points or fewer...is 16-2 all-time when allowing fewer than 90 points (6-0 this season)...the 'Horns are allowing 100.1 ppg (5th in league).

Double-Digit Dominance: Reno won by double-digits in both games this past weekend...now have won 9-of-17 games by at least 10 points...are 9-1 in games decided by double-digits...8-11 in games decided by 9 or fewer points...in 17 wins, it has won by an average of 11.4 ppg...in 12 losses, it has lost by 5.5 ppg.

Not in POB's House: 'Horns **C Patrick O'Bryant** has blocked 2 or more shots in 6-straight games...has 16 total blocks over that stretch (2.7 blocks per game)...blocked just 2 shots in first 4 games with Reno...4.4 blocks per 48 minutes is good for 4th in the D-League...had a season-high 4 blocks on 1/20 at TUL in just 14 minutes.

Biggest Little Notes in the World: Reno's 54 rebounds on Saturday set a new team-season-high...**F Marcus Landry** did not make a three-pointer on Saturday for the first time since 12/17 at NMX (had made 1 or more in 17-straight games)...Reno allowed Bakersfield to make just 30 field goals on Saturday, the lowest mark for an opponent this season.

RENO, Nev.—Just more than three minutes into the third period, Reno flipped a six-point halftime deficit into a lead it not relinquish, as the Bighorns roared back for a 98-81 victory over the Bakersfield Jam Saturday night in the Reno Events Center.

The Bighorns (17-12) opened the second half on a 14-4 run and never looked back, finishing off the back half of a weekend sweep and moving ahead of the Jam (16-12) in the NBA Development League's Western Conference standings.

Danny Green—acquired by the Bighorns this week—led the charge for Reno, scoring 20 points with a game-high 11 rebounds and four assists.

"I think Danny's done a great job," said Bighorns Head Coach Eric Musselman. "Friday night I think he put too much pressure on himself, and tonight he played much more relaxed."

Donald Sloan poured in 22 for Reno, while Jeremy Lin, playing on NBA assignment from the Golden State Warriors, finished with 16 points, nine boards and five assists.

"Donald Sloan just keeps getting better and better, and keeps gaining confidence, which is what this league is all about," Musselman said. "It's about young players developing and getting better, and he's a player who continues to grow as a point guard."

Reno forced 20 Bakersfield turnovers, while committing just nine.

"I thought the biggest thing was our defensive pressure," Musselman said. "Giving up 19 points in the third and fourth quarters, we really picked up our defensive intensity after halftime."

Derrick Byars led four Bakersfield players in double figures with 21 points and 10 rebounds. Kenny Taylor hit three three-pointers on his way to 12 points, and Jeremy Wise added 15 points, seven boards and five assists..
