The Fast Break

At a Glance: Today, Reno looks to avenge Friday's loss at Utah, which snapped a season-high and franchise-high-tying seven-game winning streak...today marks the first home game after the All-Star break for the 'Horns...after this afternoon's contest, Reno hits the road for a four-game, five-day road trip to Ft. Wayne and Bismarck...after today, nine of Reno's final 14 games will be played on the road.

All-Time Series: This afternoon's epic battle marks the 22nd all-time meeting between the Bighorns and **Norm de Silva's Utah Flash**...Reno holds the all-time edge, 11-10...Reno also holds the edge in the season series, 3-2...Utah has won two-straight against Reno after dropping the first three matchups this season...today's game is the sixth of 10 meetings between the two clubs this season...is the most games against a single opponent for both teams...Utah is Reno's opponent in each of the 'Horns' next three home games and five of their next 10 games overall.

A Star in the Making: Bighorns **F Marcus Landry** flew to Los Angeles last weekend, appearing in the D-League Three-Point Contest on Friday night and the D-League All-Star Game on Saturday afternoon...Landry was eliminated in the first round of the Three Point Contest after losing a tiebreaker to eventual champion Booker Woodfox...in the All-Star Game, Landry scored 18 points on 8-15 shooting from the floor (2-7 from three-point range)...the West fell to the East, 115-108.

Getting Defensive: Reno and Utah are two of three D-League teams to hold their opponents under 100 ppg on average...they both surrender just 99.5 ppg...only Erie (98.5 ppg) allows fewer ppg...the Bighorns are 13-3 when holding opponents under the century mark...are 9-10 when opponents score 100 points or more...10-1 in last 11 games when holding opponents under 100 points.

Taking Offense to the Opposition: Bighorns **G Danny Green** is averaging 25.7 ppg over his last three contests...has scored 28, 24 and 25 points during stretch...has scored 20+ points in five of his nine games this season, and 15+ points in eight of nine games...the 'Horns are 3-2 when Green scored 20+ points and 6-2 when he scores 15+ points...Green's 19.2 ppg average would be good for 4th in the league if he had played the minimum number of games to qualify.

Keep Firing: Reno attempted a season-high 96 field goals on Friday at Utah...was the eighth time in franchise history that the 'Horns have attempted at least 95 field goals (4-4 all-time)...the franchise record for field goal attempts in a single game is 108, set on 12/14/08 at Colorado...Reno made just 37 shots that day (34.3%) and fell to Colorado, 129-108.

Biggest Little Notes in the World: Reno is 30-13 (.698) all-time after the All-Star break (0-1) so far this season...Reno is riding a 7-game home winning streak...has not lost in Reno since 1/5 vs. IOW (124-109)...Reno is 3-2 on Sundays this year and 6-3 in day games...Friday marked the 4th time this season the 'Horns have allowed an opposing player to score 30+ points (Costner, 31)...fell to 1-3 when allowing a 30-point scorer.

RENO, Nev.—The Reno Bighorns' franchise-best seven-game winning streak was snapped Friday night, as the Utah Flash (20-15) dropped Reno, 112-106, in the UCCU Events Center.

Trailing by just two points after the first quarter, Reno (22-13) was outscored 35-20 in the second and would head into the break trailing by 17 points. The 'Horns fought back in the fourth, cutting the Flash lead to just three points with four minutes remaining, but could not complete the comeback.

Tonight's loss was Reno's first since Jan. 26, and it came after a season-long 12-day layoff. Reno now sits three games behind Tulsa for the best record in the Western Conference.

Danny Green paced the 'Horns with 25 points, while Donald Sloan fell just one assist shy of a triple-double, finishing with 17 points, 10 rebounds and nine assists. Anthony Richardson added 19 points and eight rebounds for Reno.

Brandon Costner was the difference for Utah, scoring 21 of his game-high 31 points in the first half. Kevin Kruger chipped in with 19 points while connecting on 4-8 from beyond the arc.

Reno won the rebounding battle 51-43, but Utah's bench outscored Reno's 33-18 on the evening.
