The Fast Break

At a Glance: This afternoon, the Bighorns play the first playoff game in franchise history...they are riding a franchise-best 7-game winning streak...this will be the Bighorns 6th-straight home game and 10th in their last 12 games...Reno finished the regular season by winning 12 of its final 15 games.

All-Time Series: Today's titanic struggle marks the 7th all-time meeting between the Bighorns and Alex Del Barrio's Rio Grande Valley Vipers...the all-time series is tied at 3 game apiece...RGV has taken 3 of the 4 meetings between the 2 clubs this season...the 2 teams split 2 games in Reno this season, while RGV won both games played in Texas...RGV has held **G Desmon Farmer** to just 19.5 ppg this season, 4.2 ppg below his season average.

Playoff Picture: The NBA Development League playoff structure is unique in that the top 3 seeds (Iowa, Rio Grande Valley and Austin) selected their first-round playoff opponent from the remaining 5 qualifiers...Iowa chose the 7th-seeded Utah Flash, RGV chose Reno, and Austin chose the 5th-seeded Dakota Wizards, leaving 4th-seeded Sioux Falls to play 8th-seeded Tulsa...each series is a best-of-three series, with the lower-seeded team playing the first game at home, and games 2 and 3 (if necessary) to be played on the higher-seeded team's home floor...the Iowa/Utah and Tulsa/Sioux Falls series are tied at 1 game apiece...Austin leads Dakota 1-0 with Game 2 to be played tonight in Austin.

I Am Iron Man: University of Nevada alum **F Mo Charlo** was the only player on the Bighorns to start all 50 games this season...was 1 of only 5 players in the D-League to start 50 games during the 09-10 campaign (also Curtis Jerrells, AUS; Curtis Stinson and Pat Carroll, IOW; Larry Owens, TUL)...**G Desmon Farmer** and **C Rod Benson** started 49 games for Reno...the Bighorns have used the same starting lineup (Benson, Blalock, Charlo, Farmer, Thomas) in 28-consecutive games, going 19-9 during that stretch (.679).

Second-Half Surge: On January 9, the Bighorns were 5-12 and had lost 7-straight games...since then, Reno has gone 23-10, including a 16-5 mark since the All-Star Break...4 of its 5 losses since the break have been by 6 points or fewer...last season, the 'Horns had a similar second half, going 14-7 after the break and winning 13 of their final 18 games...Reno is 24-8 all-time in the months of March and April.

What's Wrong With This Picture? Reno and Rio Grande Valley have had vastly different relationships with the NBA this season...the Vipers have had 5 different players called-up to the NBA a record 10 times this season (Antonio Anderson; Will Conroy, 2; Mike Harris, 3; Kenny Hasbrouck; Garrett Temple, 3)...Reno has yet to have a Gatorade Call-Up to the NBA in 2 years of existence.

Biggest Little Notes in the World: Today's game marks No. 101 in Bighorns franchise history...Reno's roster boasts the D-League's all-time leading scorer (Farmer, 3,400), rebounder (Benson, 1,656) and shot-blocker (Trybanski, 321)...Farmer has led the Bighorns in scoring in 10 of the last 13 games and 30 of the 50 Bighorns games this season.

RENO, Nev.—With both teams already having secured a spot in the NBA D-League playoffs, the Reno Bighorns recorded their franchise-record seventh-straight win, 105-88, over the Tulsa 66ers in the regular-season finale Sunday afternoon in the Reno Events Center.

With the victory, the Bighorns conclude the regular season with a 28-22 record and the first postseason berth in franchise history. Reno will take-on the Rio Grande Valley Vipers in round one of the playoffs, a best-of-three series. Game one will be played in the Reno Events Center, and games two and three, if necessary, will be played at State Farm Arena in McAllen, Texas.

On Sunday afternoon, a big first quarter put Reno in control from the early-going. Tulsa battled back in the second quarter, but the Bighorns would take an eight-point lead into intermission. Reno ran away in the fourth quarter, outscoring Tulsa 34-18 in the final frame to cruise to the victory.

Desmon Farmer knocked down three three-pointers on his way to a game-high 19 points for Reno. Cezary Trybanski recorded a double-double with 17 points and 11 boards, and Yaroslav Korolev kicked-in a double-double of his own with 16 points and 10 rebounds. Reno shot 54.8 percent from the field on Sunday.

Marcus Lewis came off the bench to lead six 66ers in double figures with 14 points. Latavious Williams finished with 12 points and 12 points for Tulsa.
